

Resolution No. 09.08

A Resolution Setting an Incentive Electric Utility Rate for Heat Pumps and Geothermal Heating Systems

WHEREAS, the City of Parker desires to provide an incentive customers through its electric utility to utilize City electric utility services; and

WHEREAS, such incentives will enhance the stability of the Parker City electric utility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PARKER, South Dakota that pursuant to Section 8.0607 of the Parker City Ordinances, the City of Parker will offer a .0175 cent reduction per kilowatt hour off the then current kilowatt per hour rate for any kilowatts used by the owner or utility customer of an approved heat pump or geothermal heating system, for use over 1500 kilowatts per hour per billed month. This Resolution shall apply to any owner or utility customer having a heat pump or geothermal heating systems that meets 13 seer standards. This incentive rate shall apply to residential customers only. Months of rate incentive will include October, November, December, January, February and March of each calendar year.
